- Soup Kitchen: Groups of 5 to 7
- Pantry: Groups Up to 15
- Box Build: Groups of 15
- Building/Office/ Warehouse: Varies depending on need
- Landscape: Groups Up to 10
- Event: Varies depending on Event

FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEERS

- Processing grocery orders.
 - Load carts to be distributed into clients' cars.
 - Stocking, sorting, checking expiration dates, and shelving food donations.
 - Help unload produce, goods, and food.
 - Availability: Monday–Fridays, 8:30am–3:30pm
- Special Note:** This opportunity involves standing, bending, and lifting (between 5-50 pounds).

SOUP KITCHEN VOLUNTEERS
