WHAT IS THE HOPE HUB NIGHTLY SHELTER?

The HOPE Hub Nightly Shelter provides safe, low-barrier, overnight shelter to adults experiencing homelessness in the Kenosha community. The shelter emphasizes safety, stabilization, and connection to services in a trauma-informed, dignity-centered environment. It operates nightly to ensure individuals without safe alternatives have a place to stay.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

- Shift: 5:50pm to 9pm
- Commit to one shift/week (open 7 days/week)
- At least 21 years old and able to lift 25lbs.
- Pass a background check

VOLUNTEER DUTIES

- Setting up beds and preparing the space
- Assisting with guest intake
- Distributing hygiene and other products
- Assisting with laundry and folding bedding
- Helping with cleaning and general upkeep
- **Offering a “helping hand” or a “listening ear”**

Note: You'll have an orientation meeting before your first shift to go over all the duties. To enter the Nightly Shelter go to Door #4 at Shalom Center (Hope Hub Community Center).
